## The World's First "I Don't Wanna Swim the 1500 at Provincials" Masters Swim Meet

**Events :** #01. 800 Freestyle; #02. 1500 Freestyle

**Date :** Sunday, March 24, 2002

**Time :** Warmups : 8:00 - 8:25 am; Competition : 8:30 - 10:15 am; No Sprint Lane

**Location :** D. A. Morrison J.H.S., 271 Gledhill Avenue, Toronto; first stoplight east of Woodbine, north of Danforth.

**Facilities :**

- 6 lane, 25 metre pool.
- There are no starting blocks and no lockers.
- There are lane ropes and hot showers.

**Entries :**

- Deadline : 10:00 pm Wednesday, March 20, 2002
- Fees : \$10.00 per swimmer for one event, \$15.00 per swimmer for both events.
- Deck Entries : MAY be accepted until 8:15 am on the day of the meet, but keep in mind that the strict time limitation may prohibit deck entries.

***Entries are first come first serve and are strictly limited to fit into the available time frame. You will be informed by 10:00 pm, Thursday, March 21, if your entry has NOT been accepted. The actual number of swimmers allowed and heats to be swum is as yet unknown and will be a function of the number of entries for each event.***

**Entry Form :**

- Include name, club, birthdate, gender, phone number, address, email, event and seed time.
- Include a photo copy of your registration card.

You will be expected to be a timer for at least one heat.  
If you choose not to help, you can go home.

**Meet Procedures :**

- The events will be deck seeded by time and mixed by gender.
- The heats will be swum 2 swimmers per lane, slowest to fastest.
- The centre 4 lanes will be used for competition.
- The outside 2 lanes will be used for continuous warmup/cooldown.
- Time cards will be supplied. Splits will be recorded.
- Lane counters will be provided, but you must provide the personnel.

**Records :**

- The pool has not been measured - World Records will not be recognized.
- Ontario and Canadian Record Applications will be available.
- Bring an extra timer if you expect a record.

**The Fine Print :** No Awards. No Food. Results mailed within the week.

**The MSO Print :**

- Sanctioned by MSO
- MSO Rules apply, whichever ones are in effect on March 24, 2002
