Meet Manager clinics

Running a meet for the first time can seem like a daunting challenge – but it's not!

To demystify the process, the Ontario Swim Officials Association (OSOA) has put together a clinic on how to run a meet. Clinics are held throughout the year and across the province – and are recommended for all first time meet managers. New guidelines for reserving a meet date

New guidelines have been set for how a meet date is awarded when clubs request the same (or following) weekend. Generally, it is the policy of MSO not to allow 2 meets to be held at the same time if they will be drawing from the same region to ensure both meets will succeed. This region is defined as anything within a 60-90minute drive from each other.
