Welcome to the first annual Over the Falls Wolverine Classic. Our facility, the E. Paul Maynard Natatorium at Niagara Falls High School, is a 6-lane, 25-yard pool (all deep) with non-turbulent lane lines, equipped with a state of the art six-lane Daktonics timing system with an alpha-numeric scoreboard which displays names and graphics along with racing times and a separate area for continuous warm-up/down. This is the one of the fastest pools in Western New York that should allow for some very fast times.

**ENTRIES:** Must be received by November 27, 2006. Competitors may enter up to 5 individual events. The meet is open to all Masters Swimmers hold a valid 2006 USMS or CASA registration card. **A copy of this card must accompany your entry!** Age is determined by a swimmers age on December 2, 2006. 2006 USMS rules and regulation apply.

**HOSPITALITY:** Bagels, fruit and drinks will be available free for all competitors during the meet.

**AWARDS:** Awards for 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> place finishers.

**From Canada & North:** Take exit 23, Porter/Packard Road off the I-190. Turn right at light onto Porter Road. Go, approximately 1 mile, to the second traffic light and turn left into the school. Go around the traffic circle towards the left side of the school. Enter door #3. Follow signs to the pool.
