



**Confirmation of Review of Concussion Awareness Resource
(Coach)**

Rowan's Law on Concussion Safety is provincial legislation that came into effect on July 1, 2019. The Law applies to Masters Swimming Ontario because our membership includes swimmers under 26 years of age.

Under Rowan's Law, Masters Swimming Ontario and your club must ask you to confirm that you reviewed Concussion Awareness Resources available on the Government of Ontario's website. The law requires this confirmation to be collected ANNUALLY and PRIOR to participating in MSO activities.

The Ministry resources include a list of common signs and symptoms of a concussion. It also provides access to a booklet for review.

MSO recommends that coaches, trainers and officials also refer to the more detailed concussion management materials published by Swim Canada and especially the resources provided by Parachute Canada.

Retain a copy of this confirmation form and use it in the event that you work with more than one club or more than one sport.
