Seniors set new records

Despite their 'advancing years', they took to the water like babes.

"I know I'm in better shape now than at any other time in my life," said Don Harvey of Edmonton, following his 50-metre backstroke victory in the 65-69 age class last night in the first day of the three-day Canadian Masters National Swimming Championships which are being held at the Pan-Am Pool.

His time was one minute, 7.9 sec-

Harvey and his cohorts — ranging in age from 20 to 75 — plunged back into the waters at 9 o'clock this morning. The final day of the meet starts tommorow at 9 a.m.

Unlike many of the competitors here, who were weaned on competitive swimming and have held records at the provincial and national level in bygone years, the retired 65-year-old Harvey has only been in the sport for five years.

"When I started training, I certainly hated to go to work the next morning. Now I feel great."

That was five years ago when his team, Edmonton Masters Swim Club, was formed. Since that time, the club has grown from 15 members to more than 100.

Thirty of those swimmers are here, including former national calibre swimmers Corinne Whelan, John Sutton and Karen Nelson.

It appears they haven't lost their touch, as each had a hand in establishing national records.

Whelan earned hers in the 25-29 class with a clocking of 38.5 in the 50-metre backstroke. Sutton helped his 200-metre freestyle team enter the record book with a time of 2:07.22 in the 35-39 class while Nelson's record came in the 25-29

class with an impressive 20:58.71 in the 1,500-metre freestyle.

Nelson was not alone. Other national 1,500-metre marks fell in the wake of Toronto's Marny Hough, 35, and Mary Grace, 30. Hough's time was 23:32.42 and Grace clocked 24:55.

In the men's 1,500-metre freestyle, eight men eclipsed the national mark for their respective age classifications — Austins' John Bell of Texas; John Cuthbertson of Calgary; John Starratt and Neil Handlesman of Edmonton; Len Minty and Jack Galvin of North York, Ont.; Toronto's Ted Roach and George Milne.

Bell, competing in the 30-34 age class, topped the field with a time of 18:45.21.

England's 64-year-old Willy Van Rysel of Bouremouth eclipsed the world mark in the women's 100-metre backstroke as the three-day Canadian Masters National swimming championships concluded yesterday at the Pan-Am Pool.

Van Rysel of the British Long Distance Swimming Association lowered the standard in her 60-64 age group to one minute, 41.25 seconds.

With four Canadian records to her credit, she also led the parade of swimmers who had shattered a total of 99 national marks before the meet had ended.

Winnipeg's Catherine Kerr, who stroked to three national marks, stopped the Englishwoman's bid for a fifth record.

Kerr of the Winnipeg Synchronized Swim Club defeated her by almost three metres in the 50-metre freestyle, clocking 37.5 seconds as opposed to Van Rysel's 41.3.

Kerr's other record times were a 54.6 in the 50-metre breaststroke and 1:27.57 in the 100-metre freestyle.

"I'm pleased with my times as I will be in a good position when I change age groups," said Van Rysel, who will celebrate her 65th birthday in July. "I've been competing most of my life

and plan to continue.

Once a sprinter

"I was a sprinter before the Second World War broke out, then changed to distance swimming."

She trains three times a week and logs about two miles in each outing. Some of her training is done in the ocean.

"The water temperature is sometimes in the low 50-degree range but when we have a real warm summer it will sometimes rise by as much as 10 degrees. I really like swimming in the ocean when it's warm."

Although it was her first trip to Winnipeg which she defrayed the cost of herself, it was her second trip to Canada.

She was in Toronto three years ago for the world championships.

"Now that I'm retired, swimming gives me a purpose to travel."

Others, retired or still active in the working world, came from across Canada as well as from New York and Austin, Tex., to compete at the Pan-Am Pool

While many out-of-province swimmers plunged into the record book, including the stars from bygone years like Edmonton's Coreen Whelan, John Sutton, John Starratt and Karen Nelson and breaststroker Paul Naisby of Montmagny, Que., local swimmers also added their names to the record book.

In addition to Kerr, other Winnipeggers establishing national marks were John Bell of the St. James Seals and Jim McDiarmit of WSSC.

Sets three national marks

Bell, a former provincial record holder, eclipsed three national freestyle marks in the 50-54 age group. His times were a speedy 29.6 in the 50 metre, 1:08.85 in the 100 metre and a 2:48.63 in the 200 metre.

McDiarmit, who is still active at 71 in teaching youngsters to swim, also added his name to three records. Those marks were 1:54.32 in the 100-metre freestyle, 1:57.50 in the 100-metre breaststroke and a 47.10 at the 50-metre distance.

"I could never beat Bobby Hamerton," said McDiarmit of the former Olympian of the 1936 Berlin Games. "It's nice to know things haven't changed. He was beating me 60 years ago at Grand Beach and he can still beat me in the sprint freestyle."

Hamerton, although it wasn't a record swim, cruised a powerful 33 seconds to win the 50-metre freestyle in the 70-74 class. McDiarmit was well back, clocking a 38.9.
